We were putting together workshop and show series ideas for the 2011 show and fair season. While we were at AkSarBen this past September we had the opportunity to talk with Kirk Steirwalt. We asked Kirk what it would take to have him present a 3-day clinic to interested exhibitors in our area. He was thrilled to be asked and said he would love to present the clinic so close to his hometown. He even told stories about how he showed animals in Warren County out in front of the grandstand.

Martin and I are looking forward to this opportunity to allow local exhibitors the chance to learn from one of the best, if not the best, in the cattle fitting and showing industry. We are sending this letter to the exhibitors that attended the Show Series last year. We are not limiting exhibitors to this list, but it was a start for us to get the word out.

The clinic will be held at the Warren County Fairgrounds on April 29th, 30th, and May 1st. We will use barn #1 and the show ring for the clinic. The clinic is limited to the first 20 exhibitors that pay the deposit. Cost is \$300.00 per exhibitor. Exhibitor means the person that will hold the clippers and only one person per chute will hold the clippers to work the animal. Parents will need to watch from the stands. It is not only encouraged, but also a must to be able to bring your own animal and equipment so Kirk can help each exhibitor with each animal's problem areas.

We have the registration forms prepared. We are putting the final details on the schedule with Kirk. Preliminarily, the clinic will start on Friday, April 29th, at 5:00 PM and end on Sunday, May 1st at 3:00 PM.

I cannot stress enough that we are only allowed 20 exhibitors with chutes at the clinic. We will keep a waiting list.
